The historic Hippodrome Theater, located at the heart of the new France-Merrick Performing Arts Center in downtown Baltimore, has been restored to its former splendor following an extensive \$65 million dollar renovation.

- 1:00-3:30 - **“The Book of Mormon” at the Hippodrome Theater** – Composed by *South Park* creators Trey Parker and Matt Stone and *Avenue Q*’s Robert Lopez and winner of 9 Tony awards including Best Musical, *The Book of Mormon* is an old-style musical with a modern sensibility. This blockbuster show features several big song-and-dance numbers accompanied by some old-fashioned Broadway belting. This outrageous musical comedy follows the misadventures of a mismatched pair of missionaries, sent halfway across the world to spread the Good Word. *The Book of Mormon* follows two young missionaries who are sent to Uganda to try to convert citizens to the Mormon religion. One missionary, Elder Price, is an enthusiastic go-getter with a strong dedication to his faith, while his partner, Elder Cunningham, is a socially awkward but well meaning nerd whose tendency to embroider the truth soon lands him in trouble. Upon their arrival in Africa, Elders Price and Cunningham learn that in a society plagued by AIDS, poverty and violence, a successful mission may not be as easy as they expected.

An equal opportunity offender, the show playfully pokes fun at religion, sexuality, poverty and race, while inspiring an after-the-show discussion of religion in general. Now an international sensation, *The New York Times* calls it "the best musical of the century."
