Gettysburg, “the most famous small town in America,” comes to life during the holiday season as it is decked out in holiday finery paired with its rich Civil War history making it a unique holiday destination.

- 8:00 AM - leave Kohl's, Westminster (Rt. 140 & Market Street)
8:30 AM - leave Royal Farms, Littlestown
- 9:30-11:30 - **Eisenhower National Historic Site** – Visit Dwight and Mamie Eisenhower's home that served as a weekend retreat and meeting place for world leaders which is decked out for the holidays with all of Mamie's authentic holiday decorations. Have time to explore the **Gettysburg National Military Park Visitor Center** & gift shop afterwards.
- 11:45-1:15 - Lunch at **Dobbin House Tavern** – Dine in Gettysburg's oldest, most historic home built in 1776 which is open to the public as a colonial restaurant. Please pre-select from one of the following entree choices:
1) Baked chicken with mushrooms & supreme sauce
2) Broiled flounder with lemon butter
3) Baked ham with pineapple raisin sauce
Entrees served with tossed garden salad, baked potato, home baked breads, dessert, coffee, hot & iced tea.
- 2:00-3:30 - **A Christmas Carol at the Majestic Theater** – Presented by Totem Pole Playhouse, this all new adaptation of *A Christmas Carol* simply and directly tells the redemption of the human soul and preserves the beautiful language, charm and humor of Charles Dickens’ classic tale. Set in Victorian England, the miserly old Ebenezer Scrooge is visited by the ghost of his former partner, Jacob Marley, who informs him that he will be visited by three spirits: The Ghosts of Christmas Past, Present and Christmas Yet to Come. Scrooge meets these specters and learns a great deal from his past and present and glimpses what the future is to be. Over 40 actors, singers and dancers bring Dickens’ story beautifully to life with music and good humor as the giant pop-up-book of a backdrop opens so that all who see *A Christmas Carol* will discover the true magic of the holiday season.
