

SATURDAY, JULY 11, 2020 – FLIGHT 93 MEMORIAL & CHAPEL IN SHANKSVILLE, PA

- 10:30-12:30 - **Flight 93 National Memorial (Shanksville, PA)** – Honor the heroism & courage of the passengers and crew of this fateful flight on September 11, 2001. Phase 1 of the permanent memorial was dedicated on the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the terrorist attacks. The Flight 93 National Memorial **Visitor Center Complex**, dedicated on September 10th, 2015, houses an exhibit that adds a self-guided intellectual understanding to the emotional experience of walking along and viewing the crash site itself. The final resting place of the passengers and crew is the heart of the Flight 93 National Memorial and will remain untouched. Visitors can view the crash site from the **Memorial Plaza**. The names of the 40 passengers and crew are inscribed on the wall of the plaza as it follows the flight of the plane.
- Dedicated on September 9, 2018, **The Tower of Voices**, the final phase of construction, is conceived as a monumental, ninety-three feet tall musical instrument holding forty wind chimes, representing the forty passengers and crew members. The tower serves as both a visual and audible reminder of the heroism of the forty passengers and crew of United Flight 93. (NOTE: Currently eight of the 40 wind chimes are installed in the tower. Field testing of these prototype chimes is ongoing. There is no scheduled delivery date for the remainder of the chimes at this time.)
- 1:00-2:20 - Lunch at **Green Gables Restaurant (Jennerstown, PA)**. Enjoy an unforgettable dining experience in the heart of the Laurel Highlands. Please pre-select from one of the following entree choices:

- 3:00-4:00 - **Flight 93 Memorial Chapel** – This 100-year old non-denominational chapel is dedicated to honor God and the sacred memory of the 40 heroes of Flight 93. Visit the Crew Monument in the garden area behind the
