- 8:30 AM - leave Kohl's, Westminster (Rt. 140 & Market Street)
- 10:15-10:45 - Stop at **Mr. Sticky's** for an "extremely addictive sticky bun" at this bakery on wheels located at the Lancaster County Visitors Center.
- 11:00-12:25 - **Kitchen Kettle Village** (Intercourse, PA) – Kitchen Kettle Village showcases all that Lancaster County has to offer featuring a unique shopping experience with 40 distinct merchants offering everything from locally-made art, pottery and PA Dutch quilts to name-brand favorites, homemade baked goods, jams and relishes, & much more!
- 12:40-1:25 - **Bird-in-Hand Farmers Market** – Shop delicious Lancaster County offerings, including fresh meats, cheese and produce, a wide variety of baked goods, chocolates and candies, bulk foods, spices, coffee and loose leaf tea, locally made chips, hand-rolled soft pretzels, fresh-squeezed lemonade, apple cider, homemade canned goods & much more, along with souvenirs and craft merchandise. (You may wish to bring a cooler to keep purchases refrigerated.)
- 1:30-5:00 - **Cornfield Banquet** in Lancaster County – Create memories during this unique experience as you take a hayride to the Smucker Family homestead, who still have their roots in the fertile soil of Lancaster County, with family members farming and raising produce and livestock. Have the opportunity to connect with that land and its delicious bounty as you enjoy a farm-fresh meal served under a tent among the rows of corn. This authentic taste of Amish Country, along with a corn maze and entertainment, will be an experience you'll remember forever. Farm-fresh lunch menu includes barbecue chicken, fresh-picked corn on the cob prepared on-site, baked Idaho and sweet potatoes, homemade baked beans, macaroni salad, Pennsylvania Dutch chow chow, cole slaw, applesauce, rolls, butter & apple butter, whoopie pies from the Bird-in-Hand Bakery, angel food cake with seasonal berries, iced tea & lemonade.

\*Please note: This is a rain or shine event. In case of inclement weather, the banquet will be held at an alternate location indoors. Transportation to/from the farm is provided by tractor-pulled wagon with straw bales for seating. Stairs & walking on uneven ground is required & appropriate footwear is recommended.
