Enjoy a full day of iconic Chesapeake Bay culinary traditions and history to learn & consume on this progressive meal tour in Maryland's State Capital!

- 8:30 AM - leave Kohl's, Westminster (Rt. 140 & Market Street)
- 8:45 AM - leave Chartley Park Shopping Center, Reisterstown
- 10:00-11:00 - Start our tasty Annapolis tour with a historically attired guide for a guided tour of the **Maryland State House**, the first peacetime capitol of the United States and the only state house ever to have served as the nation's capitol. It is also the oldest state house in America still in continuous legislative use.

- 11:00-12:00 - Driving tour of historic Annapolis - You will hear spicy and sweet tales of the area.

 - 4) Southwest Chicken Salad (Blackened grilled chicken breast, field of greens, avocado, grape tomatoes, carrots, red onions, roasted corn salsa, cheddar cheese, tortilla strips & honey-chipotle vinaigrette)
 - 5) Caprese Penne (with tomatoes, mozzarella, basil & parmesan)
 - 6) Basil Chicken Sandwich (Basil marinated chicken breasts, garlic spinach, roasted garlic aioli, bacon & white cheddar cheese on onion-poppysseed bun served with fries)
