<u>SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 19:</u> We will begin our travels this morning making a breakfast stop at Cracker Barrel in Hagerstown, MD and a lunch stop en route. Early afternoon, we will make a "sweet stop" at **Russell Stover Chocolates** in Triadelphia, West Virginia, where you can shop Russell Stover exclusive flavors and boxes that can be found in no other stores, old fashioned handmade fudge, gourmet handmade confections and more. Then, go next door to **Cabela's**, an enormous 175,000-sq.-ft. store which not only offers quality outdoor merchandise, but also has museum-quality animal displays and huge aquariums, complete with an indoor trout stream. Experience the recently renovated Wilson Lodge which offers all of the amenities you need to feel right at home. This evening, enjoy a delicious **holiday dinner buffet and entertainment** at the Lodge overlooking Schenk Lake.

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 20: Following a **buffet breakfast** at the Lodge, we will first visit **Oglebay Institute's Glass Museum** which displays over 4,000 examples of Wheeling glass made from 1829-1939 including cut lead crystal, Victorian art glass, peachblow glass, pattern and depression glass, Northwood's carnival glass, and many other glass examples showcasing Ohio Valley history. Witness the largest piece of cut lead crystal ever made – The Sweeney Punch Bowl. Standing five feet tall and weighing 225 pounds, this remarkable piece of Victorian artistry is world renowned. Then, tour the elegant holiday decorations at the **Oglebay Mansion** **Museum**, the first museum in West Virginia to be accredited by the American Association of Museums, and placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1979. With a different theme each year, the mansion sparkles with original designs by local decorators and offers impressive collections of American furniture, china, silver, glass, pewter, toys, and textiles. Explore 13 period rooms focusing on Wheeling's earliest settlement through the opulent Edwardian era, plus the Wymer General Store and Sinclair Pharmacy collections. Afterwards, browse the Hilltop Shops, before having lunch on your own at Speidel Grill with time for browsing the Speidel Christmas Shop, a winter wonderland featuring a variety of traditional holiday décor, unique gifts, apparel & more. This afternoon, we will visit Winter Fantasy, located at Oglebay's Good Zoo, which includes an exciting Rockin' Holiday Light Show which features 40,000 LED lights choreographed to the music of legends like Led Zeppelin, Trans-Siberian Orchestra, and more, plus a spectacular Holiday Laser Show at the Good Zoo's Benedum Theater and Planetarium, a 16-minute show that includes your favorite holiday jingles featuring music from Brad Paisley and B.E. Taylor. Return to the Lodge for a **buffet dinner** before embarking with a step-on guide onboard the motorcoach who will give detailed information about the illuminated displays as we drive through Oglebay's Winter Festival of Lights. Delighting visitors since 1985, this annual light show is one of the nation's largest, covering more than 300 acres over a 6mile drive through Oglebay Park. Deemed one of the 10 Best Christmas Light Displays in the United States by AOL Travel, the festival features more than 100 larger-than-life exhibits.

<u>TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 21:</u> This morning, enjoy a **buffet breakfast** before a mid-morning departure from the Lodge. Spend some time at Wheeling's **Historic Centre Market**, an eclectic mix of locally owned shops and quality dining. Built in 1853, the Upper Market House is the eldest market house in the country. An optional shuttle will be offered for you to try your luck at **Wheeling Island & Racetrack** featuring over 1,400 of the most popular slot machines, exciting table games, and a poker room. (Must be at least 21 years of age.) We will make a dinner stop en route home with fond memories of our Oglebay Christmas Tour!
