WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 18: After breakfast, we will visit one of the Golden Isles, Jekyll Island. Join the ranks of the rich and famous at the Jekyll Island Club Resort where lunch will be included. The Legend of Bagger Vance was filmed at the historic Resort, a 19th century hunting retreat for millionaires. Discover how these empire builders, including the Rockefellers and Vanderbilts, created an exclusive gilded era island retreat for family and friends on Georgia's coast and shaped our nation's future on a narrated tram tour of Jekyll Island's historic district. Enjoy the moss draped Live Oaks and spectacular Driftwood Beach where the beautiful driftwood trees resemble a tree graveyard that will amaze you. Driftwood Beach, voted one of America's "Ten Most Romantic Beaches," is an escape to another world as ancient driftwood monuments line the waterfront, creating an unforgettable backdrop.

Shop in Ruth's Attic Bookstore and grab a bite to eat in the unique ambiance of the Graham Brothers Dairy Bar with booths that look like stalls, whimsical cow-print tablecloths, antique milk cans and family photos.
