This evening, a delicious dinner will be included at **Paula Deen's Family Kitchen**, before we attend the world-famous home of country music, the **Grand Ole Opry**. What began as a simple radio broadcast in 1925 is today a live entertainment phenomenon. The Opry is celebrating its **50**<sup>th</sup> **Anniversary at its current location in 2024**! Unlike a typical concert, the Opry features a dynamic lineup of eight or more artists on each show, coming together to celebrate the past, present and future of country music.

Enjoy a self-guided tour of Elvis' Airplanes as you step aboard Elvis' customized airplanes to see how he traveled in luxury. The *Lisa Marie* includes a living room, conference room, private bedroom and features gold-plated seatbelts, leather-covered tables and 24-karat gold-flecked sinks. Plus, you can take a glimpse at Elvis' smaller Lockheed Jetstar, the *Hound Dog II*. Lunch will be on your own at Graceland. Opened in late 2016, the Guest House Hotel is an extraordinary hotel experience inspired by Elvis Presley, located just a few steps from the gates of the iconic Graceland Mansion. This world-class resort reflects Elvis' personal style and the unique charm of Graceland and is inspired by the warm hospitality that Elvis always showed his guests. The Southern hospitality, royal treatment and luxurious amenities offered by the hotel would make the king proud! Dinner will be at your leisure this evening at one of the restaurants on property.

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 12: This morning after breakfast at the hotel, we will depart with a local guide for a city sightseeing tour of Memphis, the Bluff City. Along the tour, we will make a stop at the Peabody Hotel to see the famous Duck March which began back in the 1930s and has since become an internationally famous Peabody tradition. Another highlight of the tour will be a stop at the Danny Thomas/ALSAC Pavilion, located on the campus of St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, which commemorates the life of Danny Thomas and the history of ALSAC and St. Jude's, learn the history surrounding the founding of St. Jude, and the institution's accomplishments in the fight against catastrophic childhood diseases. Lunch will be on your own prior to visiting Sun Records Recording Studio, the birthplace of rock 'n roll, for a guided studio tour. The most famous recording studio in the world, built of blend-right-in brick and tucked into an intersection, was opened by Sam Phillips in 1950. Hear stories and music of some of the legendary artists who recorded here including Elvis Presley, Johnny Cash, Jerry Lee Lewis, Carl Perkins and many more. We will then visit the Rock & Soul Museum, created by the Smithsonian Institution, which tells the story of musical pioneers who overcame racial and socio-economic barriers to create the music that shook the world. Located at FedExForum, the museum offers a comprehensive Memphis music experience from the rural music of the 1930s, through Memphis' musical heyday in the 70s, to its global musical influence. This evening, we will have dinner at King's Palace Cafe on famous Beale Street which offers the old time Beale Street atmosphere of good food and good music. On Beale Street, Tennessee's most visited attraction and America's most iconic street, you will hear music streaming from every open door, tributes to music legends along its cobblestone walkways, and reminders of the city's rich heritage everywhere you look.

<u>WEDNESDAY</u>, <u>NOVEMBER 13</u>: Following breakfast and check-out, we will depart Memphis and head to **Pigeon Forge** in the Smoky Mountains making a lunch stop en route. Upon arrival, we will check into our overnight accommodations at:
